Kids Progress, Inc. Scholarship Program 2020

The Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles (HACLA) believes that investing in our communities and our youth will help our young residents get on the path to a self-sufficient future. Kids Progress Inc. (KPI), HACLA's non-profit affiliate, provides scholarships to encourage students to pursue higher education following high school. The program is open to public housing and Section 8 residents who are graduating seniors and who will be enrolled in a vocational or technical school, community college or four-year university in the fall of 2020.

Scholarships of \$500 - \$1,000 will be awarded to selected graduating high school students.

Selected scholarship recipients must participate in The KPI Scholarship Celebration at the University of Southern California (USC) on June 4, 2020.

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

Applications will be available at www.hacla.org, Boys and Girls Clubs located in Public Housing, Project SOAR, and HACLA Management Offices.

1. Applicants must be HACLA residents who will be graduating from an accredited public, charter, or private high school in 2020.
2. Applicants must enroll full-time beginning with the 2020 fall semester/quarter, or provide a college acceptance letter for the 2020 fall enrollment period.
3. Applicants must maintain a minimum of a 2.5 grade point average.
4. Applicants must have demonstrated strong community involvement.
5. Applicants must have a valid Social Security Number or IRS issued Tax ID PIN
6. Applicants must have completed the FAFSA application.
7. Children or dependents of elected or appointed officials are not eligible.
8. Children or dependents of HACLA employees are not eligible.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Carefully complete the application, listing all pertinent facts relating to your personal and academic achievements. Additional sheets of paper may be attached.
2. Submit a copy of your most recent transcript from school.
3. Provide a letter of recommendation from **a teacher, professor, or community leader.**
4. Enclose with your application, a recent photo of yourself, such as your school photo, and preferably a color headshot measuring at least 3"x 5." This photo may be used in marketing materials if you are selected as a scholarship recipient.
5. Provide a letter of acceptance from the college/university that you will be attending this fall.
6. **Return the completed application and all other materials, including the transcript and photo, to a designated HACLA employee at the management office of the public housing development where the applicant resides. Applications must be submitted no later than **Friday, April 17, 2020**, unless otherwise requested by written notice from a representative of HACLA.**
7. For additional information, please contact your program representative listed on the application.

SELECTION AND VERIFICATION PROCESS

Representatives of HACLA and KPI to identify and select scholarship recipients. The Housing Authority has the final responsibility for selecting recipients, and decisions of the agency are final.

The scholarship will be awarded for the 2020 fall semester/quarter, and it will be issued upon receipt of verification of full-time enrollment. Verification is due and must be received as soon as a student is enrolled, and in any event not later than **September 1, 2020** (postmarks not accepted). HACLA will follow-up with scholarship recipients to provide additional information regarding their awards.

PROGRAM LIMITS

1. HACLA retains the right to change or terminate this program at any time, without notice.
2. HACLA is not responsible for lost applications, lost verification of enrollment, or information or materials misplaced or delayed through the mail or other delivery processes.
3. Once submitted, all information and materials become the property of HACLA, and will not be returned. All information will be kept confidential.
4. Children or dependents of elected or appointed officials are not eligible.
5. Children or dependents of HACLA employees are not eligible.

RELEASE REGARDING PHOTOS OF APPLICANT

By applying for this scholarship, the applicant and/or parent/guardian irrevocably release and grant the Housing Authority any residual, moral or legal rights in and to the photographs, images or pictures, including all negatives or forms of media used, taken by either of them in connection with this scholarship application.

The utilization rights granted hereby shall include all future rights of use by HACLA (including its parent, subsidiaries and affiliates), and its advertising representatives, at any time hereafter. Such uses may include various advertising, training, publicity, promotional and other uses regarding HACLA and its activities, and may appear in any form of media — including print, video, motion picture, still photographs, Internet postings and other electronic formats, or be otherwise reproduced.

Materials relating to the applicant may be combined with other materials related to such uses, including other applicants, customers or employees of HACLA (or its parent or affiliates).

Kids Progress, Inc. Programa de Becas 2020

La Autoridad de Vivienda de la ciudad de Los Angeles (HACLA) cree que la inversión en nuestras comunidades y nuestros jóvenes ayudan a nuestros jóvenes residentes consiguen en el camino hacia un futuro autosuficiente. Kids Progress Inc. (KPI), afiliado sin fines de lucro de la HACLA ofrece becas para alentar a los estudiantes a cursar estudios superiores después de la preparatoria. El programa está abierto a los residentes de HACLA y Sección 8 que son mayores de graduación que serán inscritos en una escuela profesional o técnica, colegio comunitario o universidad de cuatro años en el otoño de 2020.

Becas de \$ 500 - \$ 1,000 serán otorgadas a los estudiantes de secundaria seleccionados de graduarse.

Cada candidato seleccionado debe participar en la celebración de becas en Junio 4, 2020 en La Universidad de Southern California (USC).

Elegibilidad

Las aplicaciones estarán disponible en la red www.hacla.org, Boys and Girls Clubs ubicados en vivienda pública, Project SOAR y las oficinas de gestión de HACLA.

1. Los estudiantes deben ser residentes de HACLA que van a graduarse de escuela high school o secundaria privada en 2020.
2. Los estudiantes deben inscribirse a tiempo completo a partir del semestre de otoño 2020 / trimestre o proporcionar una carta de aceptación de la universidad para el período de inscripción el otoño de 2020.
3. Mantener un mínimo de un promedio de 2.5 grado.
4. Los estudiantes deben haber demostrado una fuerte participación de la comunidad.
5. Los estudiantes deben tener un seguro social válido o IRS emitió PIN de identificación fiscal
6. Los solicitantes deben haber completado la solicitud FAFSA
7. Los niños o dependientes de funcionarios elegidos o nombrados no son elegibles.
8. Los niños o dependientes de los empleados de HACLA no son elegibles.

CÓMO APLICAR

1. Llenar cuidadosamente la aplicación, una lista de todos los datos pertinentes relacionados con sus logros personales y académicos. Hojas de papel adicionales pueden estar unidos.
2. Presentar una copia de la transcripción de su escuela.
3. Entregue una carta de recomendación de un maestro, profesor o líder de la comunidad.
4. Incluye una foto reciente de ti mismo, como su foto de la escuela, de preferencia una foto de rostro, al menos, 3" x 5". Esta foto puede ser utilizada en material de marketing si es seleccionado como receptor.
5. Incluye una carta de aceptación de la universidad / universidad que va a asistir este otoño.
6. **Devuelva la solicitud completa y otra información, incluyendo la transcripción y la foto a la oficina de gestión del complejo de su vivienda pública. Las solicitudes deben ser enviadas a más tardar **Viernes, 17 de abril 2020** a menos que sea solicitado por un aviso por escrito de un representante de la HACLA.**

SELECCIÓN Y PROCESO DE VERIFICACIÓN

Representantes de HACLA y KPI identificarán y seleccionarán a los becarios. La Autoridad de Vivienda tiene la responsabilidad final para la selección de los becas, y las decisiones de la agencia son finales.

La beca se otorgará para el semestre de otoño 2020 / trimestre, y que será publicado sobre la recepción de verificación de la inscripción a tiempo completo. La verificación debe ser recibidos tan pronto como un estudiante está inscrito, y en cualquier caso antes del Septiembre 1 de 2020 (matasellos no aceptada). HACLA hará un seguimiento con los becarios para proporcionar información adicional con respecto a sus premios.
