

## INCOME LIMITS FOR ADMISSION TO THE PUBLIC HOUSING PROGRAM

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This Exhibit sets forth the maximum income limits for eligibility for admission to low-rent public housing.

### I. GENERAL

- A. The annual income limits are established by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)
- B. Annual income is the applicant family's income before any deductions.

### II. INCOME LIMITS

Effective May 31, 2011 the following income limits shall apply:

### III. FAMILY SIZE ADJUSTMENTS

For income limits for families with more than eight persons, add 8% of the 4-person base to the 8-person income limit.

Number of Persons in Family and Percentage Adjustments							
1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8
70%	80%	90%	Base	108%	116%	124%	132%

Example: For a family of 9 would equal 140% (132% + 8%).

Family Size	30%	Very Low Income	Low Income
9	\$38,840	\$59,780	\$95,620
