### **Housing Authority to use \$25M in Stimulus Money to Improve Public Housing**

LOS ANGELES – The Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles (HACLA) announced today it will use \$25 Million in Federal Stimulus money to make improvements to public housing developments.

“The infusion of stimulus money means an opportunity to provide a better, greener and safer living environment for our residents. The money will also be used to fix more than 200 units to provide housing opportunities for families most in need,” said President and CEO of HACLA, Rudolf C. Montiel.

The funds appropriated under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) will go to the following projects to improve the conditions at various public housing sites.

<b>PROJECT</b>	<b>SCOPE OF WORK</b>
Repair fire/water damage units	Restoration of fire and/or water damaged units at various public housing sites.
Asbestos abatement and floor replacement	Removal of asbestos flooring and replacement of floor tiles with greener products
Reroofing of public housing buildings	Replace roofs at various public housing sites to reduce heating and cooling demands.
Security cameras and lights	Installation of security cameras and lights at public housing sites.
Water and energy conservation	Installing sprinklers and irrigation systems as well as gas lines to conserve water and energy throughout the Authority’s public housing sites
