EMERGENCY HOUSING VOUCHERS

The Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles (HACLA) is administering the Emergency Housing Voucher Program authorized by the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act of 2021.

The Emergency Housing Vouchers (EHV) have several benefits that are geared to promote owner participation in making units available for individuals and families:

Higher Voucher Payment Standards (VPS)

Higher rents as supported by comparable rents

Vacancies can be listed
