



Build Hope Scholarship Program 2022

Investing in our youth will help our residents to reach their goals. Build Hope, Inc., is HACLA's non-profit affiliate which provides scholarships to encourage students to pursue higher education following high school. In collaboration with the Community Safety Partnership Bureau (CSPB), the program is open to public housing and Section 8 residents who are graduating seniors or have a GED / high school equivalency, who will be enrolled in a vocational or technical school, community college, or four-year university in the **fall of 2022**. In addition, the scholarship application is open to prior scholarship recipients who are continuing scholars enrolled in college, university or vocational program on a full-time basis.

Scholarships of \$500 - \$2,000 will be awarded to selected students.

Selected scholarship recipients must participate in The Build Hope, Inc. Scholarship Celebration. The date is TBD in June 2022.

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

Applications will be available at Hacla.org (Scroll below to bottom of page under “Key Resources”; click on “Scholarship Application”)

1. Applicants must be **HACLA residents** who will be graduating from an accredited public, charter or private high school in 2022, or have a GED /high school equivalency who plan to pursue a higher education, including prior scholarship recipients who are continuing scholars already enrolled in college or a vocational program.
2. Applicants must be **enrolled on a full-time basis** for the 2022 fall semester/quarter or provide a college acceptance letter for the fall 2022 enrollment period.
3. Applicants must maintain a minimum of a **2.5 grade point average**.
4. Applicants must have demonstrated strong **community involvement**.
5. Applicants must have a **valid Social Security Number or IRS issued Tax ID PIN**.
6. Applicants must have completed the **FAFSA or Dream Act application**.
7. Children or dependents of elected or appointed officials are not eligible.
8. Children or dependents of HACLA employees are not eligible.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Carefully complete the application. Please list all pertinent facts related to your personal and academic achievements. Additional sheets of paper may be attached.
2. Submit a copy of your most **recent transcript** from school. (Unofficial is okay) If you cannot obtain a transcript, please provide a screenshot of your online grade portals to show current overall GPA.
3. Provide a **letter of recommendation** from a teacher, professor, or community leader.

4. Enclose with your application, a **recent photo** of yourself, preferably a clear photo of you participating in your community or in school. This photo may be used in marketing materials if you are selected as a scholarship recipient.
5. For graduating seniors, provide a **letter of acceptance** from the college/university that you will be attending this fall. For returning scholars who were prior scholarship recipients, provide a **registration letter** showing proof of continued enrollment.
6. **Return the completed application** and all other required materials, including confirming GPA documentation, essays, and jpeg, jiff, or pdf photo, via email by submitting online via google forms or emailing Aracely.Hernandez@hacla.org if you encounter issues.

SELECTION AND VERIFICATION PROCESS

Representatives of HACLA and BUILD HOPE, Inc. will identify and select scholarship recipients. The Housing Authority has the final responsibility for selecting recipients, and the decisions of the agency are final.

The scholarship will be awarded for the 2022 fall semester/quarter or vocational training date, and it will be issued upon receipt of **verification of full-time enrollment**. Verification is due and must be received as soon as a student is enrolled not later than **September 1, 2022** (postmarks not accepted). HACLA will follow-up with scholarship recipients to provide additional information regarding their awards.

PROGRAM LIMITS

1. HACLA retains the right to change or terminate this program at any time, without notice.
2. HACLA is not responsible for lost applications, lost verification of enrollment, or information or materials misplaced or delayed through the mail or other delivery processes.
3. Once submitted, all information and materials become the property of HACLA, and will not be returned. All information will be kept confidential.

Programa de Becas Build Hope 2022

La Autoridad de Vivienda de la ciudad de Los Angeles (HACL A) cree que la inversión en nuestras comunidades y nuestros jóvenes ayudará a nuestros residentes juveniles seguir un camino hacia un futuro autosuficiente. Build Hope, Inc., una organización afiliado sin ánimo de lucro de la HACL A, ofrece becas para motivar a los estudiantes a seguir estudios superiores después de la preparatoria. En colaboración con la Oficina de Asociación de Seguridad Comunitaria (CSPB), el programa está abierto a los residentes de HACL A y Sección 8 que se gradúan o han completado su GED / la equivalencia de completar la preparatoria y que serán inscritos en una escuela profesional o técnica, colegio comunitario, o universidad de cuatro años en el **otoño de 2022**. Además, la solicitud de beca está abierta a académicos que recibieron esta beca anteriormente y que están inscritos en programas de colegio, universitarios, o vocacionales a tiempo completo.

Becas de \$ 500 - \$ 2,000 serán otorgadas a los estudiantes seleccionados.

Cada candidato seleccionado debe participar en la celebración virtual de becas en una fecha pendiente en Junio, 2022

ELEGIBILIDAD

Las aplicaciones estarán disponible en la red Hacla.org (Deslize hacia abajo de la pagina, debajo de "Key Resources", haga clic en "Scholarship Application")

1. Los estudiantes deben ser **residentes de HACL A** que van a graduarse de una secundaria publica, charter, o privada en 2022 o han completado su GED / la equivalencia de completar la preparatoria, incluyendo los estudiantes continuos que recibieron esta beca anteriormente y ya están matriculados en el colegio, la universidad, o un programa vocacional.
2. Los estudiantes deben inscribirse a **tiempo completo de estudio** a partir del semestre o trimestre del otoño 2022, o proporcionar una carta de aceptación del colegio o la universidad para el período de inscripción del otoño de 2022.
3. Mantener un mínimo de un promedio de calificaciones de **2.5 GPA**
4. Los estudiantes deben haber demostrado una **participación sólido en la comunidad**.
5. Los estudiantes deben tener un **seguro social válido o un PIN de identificación** del IRS.
6. Los solicitantes deben haber **completado la solicitud FAFSA o Dream Act**.
7. Los niños o dependientes de funcionarios elegidos o nombrados no son elegibles.
8. Los niños o dependientes de los empleados de HACL A no son elegibles.

CÓMO APLICAR

1. Llenar cuidadosamente la aplicación, notando todos los datos pertinentes relacionados con sus logros personales y académicos. Hojas de papel adicionales pueden ser agregadas.
2. Presentar una copia de la **transcripción reciente** de su escuela (no oficial esta bien). Si no puede obtener la transcripción, puede proveer una foto/captura de pantalla de su portal de grados en el la red para demostrar su GPA actual en general.
3. Entregar una **carta de recomendación** de un maestro, profesor, o líder de la comunidad.
4. Incluir una **foto reciente** de ti mismo, con tu aplicación. De preferencia una foto clara de ti participando en tu comunidad o escuela. Esta foto puede ser utilizada en material de marketing si es seleccionado como becario.
5. Para estudiantes recién graduados, incluir una **carta de admisión** del colegio / la universidad que va a asistir este otoño. Para académicos que regresan, por favor entreguen una **carta de registracion** demostrando que siguen asistiendo al colegio por tiempo completo.
